The Council has received an application from Mr Calum Davies on land at Land 300M West Of Unit 3-7 Cromarty Firth Industrial Park Invergordon. The application is development falling within the Regulations as Environmental Impact Assessment development and accordingly is supported by an Environmental Impact Assessment Report.
